



2011 Guidelines for All Eagle Awards

Except for the award for individual recognition, the Eagle Award program is designed for individual quarry locations. It is not a company wide program but relates to activities at an individual location. The Eagle Award for **Individual Recognition** is open to all members in all membership divisions.

The focus is on the activities of individual quarry operations and reflect programs that are developed on a corporate basis. The individual quarry may be implementing a corporate program but the selection will be based on the specific activities of the individual location.

The **Safety Award** has an objective standard that is based on information reported to MSHA. The tabulation for this award will be made by the GCAA office.

For **Environmental Sustainability** and the **Community Relations** awards, a committee consisting of individuals or groups not directly employed in the industry will be used. The purpose is to achieve the maximum objectivity in the selection process.

The award presentations will be made at the annual Midyear Meeting.

A separate application is available for each award.
