

# GCAA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS



The program is primarily intended for students entering their first year of a two or four year college or technical college program. Students currently in college that have never received a GCAA Scholarship award may be eligible. Schools must be accredited by nationally recognized accreditation organization. Awards are based on the scholastic achievement of applicants and recognizing their involvement in extracurricular and community-based activities.

The scholarships are limited to dependents of employees working for a GCAA member company. The employee must have a minimum of one year continuous service with the company.

Scholarships are a one-time award up to \$4,000 paid directly to the school upon proof of enrollment.
