## GCAA Scholarship Program

Dear Applicant:

The Georgia Construction Aggregate Association through the GCAA Foundation is opening the application period for our 2019 Scholarship awards. The ***GCAA Scholarship Program*** is available to the dependents of any employee of a GCAA member company. The parent or guardian must be employed by a GCAA member company with at least one year of continuous service and domiciled in Georgia. In addition to students entering their first year of a two or four year college program, any student currently enrolled in a technical college and has not previously been awarded a GCAA scholarship is eligible.

The scholarship is a one-time award from \$750 to \$2000 payable directly to the school of choice upon proof of enrollment. School must be accredited by a nationally recognized accreditation organization. There is no required minimum GPA although it may be taken into account in the final recipient selection. **School transcripts must be provided with application.** *In addition, an essay not to exceed 500 words is required along with an outline of extracurricular activities, community involvement and the student's career goals.* An emphasis will be placed on students that are pursuing a technical degree in science or engineering.
