KAYAKING THE GUANA RIVER ESTUARY

Guana River Coastal Estuary was voted the “Best Place to Kayak” by Folio Weekly three years in a row. Located just north of historic St. Augustine, Guana Reserve is the 25th National Estuarine Research Reserve in the U.S. offering 60,000 acres of pristine estuary to explore. This outing will be a great combination of time on the water and the opportunity to explore the magnificent ecosystem along the banks in the State Park. Your guide is passionate about the area and will share his vast knowledge with vigor! Included are sand dunes, salt marshes and tidal creeks, maritime hardwood hammock, freshwater depression marshes and a shell mound forest.

NURSERY GUIDELINES

Nursery Hours

Monday to Friday	8am - 7pm
Saturday	8am - 4pm
Sunday	8am - 12 Noon

Holiday Hours will be posted.

The following rules are to ensure that the proper care is given to your children and to provide the safest possible environment. We appreciate your cooperation.

- We will have a maximum capacity of thirty (30) Children at one time, including a maximum of five (5) infants between the age of 6 months and up to the age of 18 months.
- Reservations are requested 12 hours and up to a week in advance for infants. Failure to cancel your reservation will result in a full charge based on the length of your reservation.
- The Nursery fees are; **Non Gym Member** \$5 per hour for the first child in the family; \$3 per hour, per sibling(s) in the same family. **Gym Members:** \$4 per hour for the first child in the family; \$2 per sibling (s) in the same family. For your child's well-being, we request that all parents or guardians remain in the areas designated for Nursery usage. These areas are: The Gym, The Spa, The Racquet Club, The Surf Club, and dining outlets. In case of any urgent child-care issue, our nursery staff must have immediate access to the parents or guardians of the children in our care. Therefore, the Nursery is not to be utilized by those members or guests on the golf courses, beach or jogging courses.
- The Nursery has a three (3) hour time limit per day with a maximum of one visit per day. Members or guests exceeding this will be charged \$10 per child for the first 15 minutes and \$10 for every 15 minutes thereafter over the three (3) hour time limit. This charge also applies for children left after the Nursery hours.
- To protect the well-being of others, children with any symptoms of illness are not allowed in the Nursery. Illness symptoms include (but are not limited) to: runny nose, sneezing, cough, watery eyes, fever rash, fatigue, pink eye, open sores, vomiting and digestive disorders. If your child has any allergies, including food allergies, please advise our nursery attendant.
- If a child is upset or disruptive, our staff will make a reasonable attempt to pacify and involve the child in activities for no more than 15 minutes. Please be prepared to respond if a staff member requests that you return to pick up your child.
- You may bring snacks for your child. We request that you permanently label all cups and/or food containers with your child's name. We are happy to occasionally provide generic snacks for those children who do not have their own. If you object to your child participating in "snack time" for any reason, please advise the nursery attendant. Due to peanut allergies, we have prohibited any peanuts or products containing peanuts from being brought into the nursery.
- Please have your infant fed and in clean diapers before dropping him or her off. Bring a supply of disposable diapers and "baby wipes". There will be a \$5 charge per diaper.
- Children must be fully clothed. Wet bathing suits are not permitted in the Nursery.
- Members must be present to authorize any guest charges.
- Failure to comply with Nursery will result in the revoking of nursery privileges.
