# **GCAA Foundation**

## **2021 Scholarship Program Guidelines**

1. The scholarship program is available exclusively to students whose parent or guardian have been employed by a GCAA member company with at least one year of continuous service and domiciled in Georgia.
2. Students who are currently enrolled (or will be enrolled) in a two-year, four year or technical college program. They must not have previously been awarded a GCAA Foundation scholarship.
3. Scholarships are paid directly to the school upon proof of enrollment. If award is sent to designated school and awardee does not attend school, the school will be contacted and request made to return funds.
4. The Sonya Machemehl Award is available to a female student seeking an engineering or science degree. This is a \$2000 award with Vulcan matching the donation made by Charles Machemehl.
5. Eligibility is based on scholastic achievement with an emphasis on community involvement demonstrated in an essay not to exceed 500 words. An emphasis may be placed on students that are pursuing engineering or science degree.
6. An application form is distributed to all member companies. Scholarship application include the following items:
  - GCAA Application
  - High School Transcripts
  - Essay on aspiration goals
  - Outline of community and school activities
7. A minimum GPA is not required but may be considered in final selections.
8. The GCAA Foundation Board members will determine the final awards.
